ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

I

The name of this corporation is **SCIRA, Inc.**

II

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit **PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION** and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to operate and maintain a public access repeater system to provide amateur radio emergency communications coverage for a wide area of Southern California, including but not limited to Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino Counties. The Association will sponsor linked repeater system stations located in, but not limited to the San Gabriel and San Bernardino Mountain ranges in Southern California and aid and provide communications services during disaster, national or local emergency or any other time when the public interest, convenience or necessity might be served.

A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.

B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on Propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

V

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.
